



## Build-Out Project: The Time Has Come To "Move Out"

The Build-Out Committee announced at Sunday Masses during the weekend of July 13-14 that "we are truly moving forward" toward the construction of St. Patrick's new parish hall.

"You will see and experience many physical changes in the next month and beyond here at our St. Patrick's campus," advised those who made the announcement which provided an update, timeline and schedule. "We have had Bishop Calvo's and the Reno Diocese's blessing and 'green light' to embark on our project."

At its July 11th meeting Build-Out Committee members set up definite dates for moving personnel from current parish offices in the old rectory to deacon and religious education offices within the church building and removing the contents of Moiola Hall to available space—donated by owners Ed Louie, Dan Munoz and Scott Tate for the purpose of storage and conducting Sunday morning CCD classes—in the old Walmart facility near Safeway. Both structures need to be completely vacated by Fri., Aug. 9, so that the construction crew can remove reusable parts before demolition begins on Mon., Aug. 19.

Prior to demolition a "Farewell Mass" will be held in Moiola Hall on

Sun., Aug. 11, at 11 a.m.

Groundbreaking ceremonies for the new parish hall will take place after demolition—expected to continue for two to three weeks—is completed. A Dedication Mass will be scheduled once the new parish hall is built.

Dan Munoz of Diversified Builders LLC is the contractor for the construction.

At present 116 St. Patrick families have contributed in cash, checks and pledges a total amount of \$931,801. In addition the Diocese of Reno has approved a \$500,000 loan towards the estimated \$1.5 million cost of the project.

Individuals can still offer a pledge or donation to the building fund as fundraising efforts continue now and through the coming years to meet the overall financial goal of \$1.5 million including payment of the diocesan loan. In the meantime, as the move out, demolition, and construction occur, parishioners can assist in the following ways:

- Extra boxes for moving and storage are needed. Bring any that are available to the parish office.
- A camp trailer will be used for a temporary Joanie's Food Pantry. If anyone is able to donate one for use during the period of construction, contact JoAnn Luiz at the parish office at 423-2846.
- Limited parking will be available once construction starts. The parish does not have a contract, agreement or understanding with Parkside Church to use its parking lot alongside 4th St. & Tedford Lane. Have consideration for our neighbor and find alternative or appropriate "street" parking or consider walking to the church if living close enough and able to do so.

■ **July 23**—Tues.—**Parish office closes** for actual move from old rectory to deacon/religious education offices within the church building



■ **July 24**—Wed.—**Parish office opens** at 8 a.m. in temporary location within the church building

■ **Aug. 9**—Fri.—Old rectory and Moiola Hall emptied and vacated no later than 5 p.m.

■ **Aug. 11**—Sun.—11 a.m.—**Farewell Mass** celebrated in Moiola Hall

■ **Aug. 19**—Mon.—**Demolition** of old rectory and Moiola Hall begins and expected to take 2-3 weeks

**Note:** Beginning July 24 and while the parish office is located within the church building, the church will be open for visits and prayer during business hours.
